



Fair Housing Opens Doors

Fair housing means that all people have the right to choose where they live regardless of who they are or where they come from. This includes renters, homebuyers and people obtaining a mortgage or homeowners insurance.

Federal, state and local fair housing laws guarantee that regardless of someone's race, color, religion, national origin, sex, familial status or disability, buyers and tenants can choose the housing that's best for them.

As a buyer or tenant, do not ask your Realtor[®] to show homes or properties based on the characteristics of the neighborhoods in which the properties are located.

As a seller or landlord, do not ask your Realtor[®] to show your home or property based on the characteristics of the interested buyers or tenants.
